THE 1968 HONOREES



SAM BAUGH

Slingin' Sam still called the greatest passer and punter ever . . . holds many TCU and NFL records . . . All-American QB 1935-36 and then all-Pro with Washington Redskins . . . also top baseball-basketball star . . . later college and pro coach . . . also member of National, Texas and Pro Hall of Fames . . . a legend.

MILTON DANIEL
(1891-1958) Closely connected with the University for over 40 years . . . Frog half-back 1910-12, and 1912 captain . . . head football coach 1916-17 . . . prominent in oil, banking and other industries . . . chairman of board of trustees 1953-58 . . . left his entire estate in trust to the University.



HOWARD GRUBBS

One of the most respected men in athletics . . . great all-SWC QB, passer and leader on TCU's first SWC champions in 1929 . . . later coach, then Athletic Director 1936-50 . . . Executive Secretary of SWC since 1950 . . . member of many NCAA committees . . . integrity is a byword with Grubbs.

ABE MARTIN
Star player, great coach and Athletic Director . . . earned three letters as end . . . successful as schoolboy coach, and later at TCU 1953-1966, winning three SWC titles . . . past president of Football Coaches Association . . . recipient of coveted Stagg award for service to football . . . Honest Abe always will be remembered.
