VC Don Mills discusses campus parking changes caused by construction jobs

"WE'RE GOING TO LEARN A LOT ABOUT PEOPLE'S patterns of movement," Vice Chancellor Don Mills told the crowd attending last Tuesday's *Vision In Action* Town Hall meeting. They'd come to hear about the parking situation on campus and how it will be altered by several construction projects soon to be under way.

Work on two of the four new residence halls on the quad will begin May 15. As of May 23, the quad lot will be closed and all parking in the center of the main campus will be eliminated. The circular drive will no longer be available to motorists, although there will be limited access for trucks delivering food and mail, as well as shuttle service from remote lots.

So what happens to those accustomed to parking on the main campus? Those with reserved spaces will be offered space in a gated lot in front of Daniel-Meyer Coliseum. Don explains that no one will have their own assigned space, however, the lot will contain enough spaces to accommodate all those with the appropriate permit. They will have a swipe card or remote device to operate the gate and gain access to the reserved area. The cost will remain at \$250 for the coming year. Don noted that the automatic gates for the reserved lot will probably not yet be in place when the new system goes into effect.

Non-reserved faculty/staff parking will be available in several remote lots surrounding the stadium area and Worth Hills. Shuttle operation will be expanded, both in number of routes and in scheduled times of service. The \$75 permit fee will remain unchanged. Lots that are currently free will remain so next year.

All visitor parking will be in the Tom Brown/Pete Wright lot. Student residents of those apartments

will park in the new lots across Bellaire Drive.

The small School of Education lot behind Einstein's will be eliminated during construction of their new facilities, however, it will return once the new building is complete. (Faculty and staff in the Bailey Bldg. are being relocated to the lower level of Tucker Technology Center during this interim period and will probably find the new Sav-On lot and shuttle service from Berry Street a convenient parking alternative.)

"This is a big change," Don acknowledged, noting that a transition period is to be expected as situations arise that were not taken into account. He assured the audience of faculty, staff and students that it is the University's intention to remain flexible as plans unfold and take action based on feedback received from the campus community.

About 1,200 more parking spaces were added on campus during the past year, according to Don, and about 350 of those will be taken away during construction.

Even so, there will be a net gain of 900 spaces counting the 50-60 to be opened on Odessa Ave.

In addition, several hundred more spaces are part of the GrandMarc apartment project. That figure is not included in TCU's totals, although it will help alleviate the number of students parking on campus to a considerable extent.

Academic regalia rented from Graduation Services must be picked up at the Coliseum between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Friday, May 12.

John Owings, Joe Butler to perform Reubke recital tonight in Ed Landreth

JOHN OWINGS, PROFESSOR OF PIANO, and H. Joseph Butler, University organist, will present a recital of the complete works of Julius Reubke at 7:30 p.m. tonight in Ed Landreth Auditorium. The event is free and open to the public.

A gifted student of Franz Liszt and son of a German organ builder, Reubke died in 1858 at the age of 24. He composed a small number of keyboard works including a noteworthy organ sonata on *Psalm 94*.

John and Joe have recently recorded these works on the Pro Organo label. The newly released CD will be available for purchase at the recital. ♦
