Referring to our recent conversations, I take pleasure in submitting attached summary of net costs for making the trip to San Francisco and return for the football game between the T.C.U. team and the Santa Clara University team, Saturday December 7th, 1935.

It will be noted that lunch at Denver, and meals in San Francisco and Los Angeles are not included, but all meals on the train are included.

There are no sightseeing trips, taxi fares or tips included.

These figures are intended to cover movement of "fans" who will go to the game with the band, the latter to occupy the car while in San Francisco and Los Angeles.

All the rail lines involved have agreed to operate special train for a minimum of 100 paid fares.
