Fifteen cents an ounce or fraction from any point on National Air Transport Line (Dallas-Ft. Worth-Chicago) to any point on U. S. Air Mail Route, Chicago to New York, including rail connection from or to air lines where necessary.

Twenty-five cents an ounce or fraction from any point on National Air Transport Line (Dallas-Ft. Worth-Chicago) to Hartford or Boston, including rail connection from or to air lines where necessary.

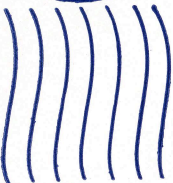
