Dear Member:

Press clipsheets, like the enclosed, will be issued from time to time as news developments justify, as a part of our national educational campaign in behalf of the unification of the armed forces, establishment of a single Department of Defense, and co-equal status for Army, Navy and Air. Most of the material on this sheet was timed for use in advance of, or on, Army Day, April 6, an event on which our publicists worked in close cooperation with the War Department.

This sheet has been mailed to all daily newspapers and 5,000 weeklies, as well as to news commentators at nearly 1,000 radio stations. There are additional bulk mailings to various co-operating agencies -- a total of about 15,000 for this issue. To a select list of 2,000 newspapers we have sent mats of all the pictures appearing on the enclosed sheet.

In the two months this campaign has been under way, we have distributed 52,750 pieces of mailing matter, and have written thousands of individual letters in support of unification. We shall shortly commence distribution of a one-reel film titled "Never Another Pearl Harbor". Still another educational effort is the program now under way to sponsor several thousand discussion meetings on unification in women's clubs across the nation.
