Dear Amon:

This will acknowledge your letter of the thirtieth ultimo with respect to the item of \$267,000 involved in the airport item. The airport is adjacent to the bomber plant.

This is to advise that Honorable George C. Kemble, Sam Bothwell, city manager, and Mayor McCrary have been here. I had several conferences with them and advised them upon a course of action in dealing with the matter.

As a result of their negotiations, they reached an agreement and satisfactory adjustment which will save the city of Fort Worth the \$267,000. It is not necessary to bother Judge Patterson with the matter at this time. It may possibly go to him for approval and if so and there is any difficulty about the matter, I shall undertake to have it given proper attention.
