My dear Senator Connally:

Further reference is made to your letter of November 6th, addressed to The Adjutant General, in behalf of Mr. Albert Calvin Williams of Fort Worth, Texas, who desires a commission.

Appointments in the Army Specialist Corps have recently been discontinued but all pending applications are being considered for appointment in the Army of the United States.

Mr. Williams' file indicates that his application was received by the War Department on July 24, 1942. Since that date it has been available to all War Department agencies for consideration but as yet he has not been selected for appointment.

As you no doubt know, this Service cannot initiate action toward the appointment of an individual applicant until a request is received from a War Department agency for a man of specific qualifications. The actual selection and recommendation for appointment is a function of the agency concerned.

You may be sure that in event a request is received for a candidate with Mr. Williams' particular qualifications, his application will receive every consideration.
