WASHINGTON, D. C. "The Anglo-American Oil Treaty now pending before the Committee on Foreign Relations will, in my opinion, never be ratified by the Committee. It is my view that the treaty is unfair to the American oil industry and is not necessary for the general welfare. I have been opposed to ratification since it was first submitted to the Committee."
