Have been requested by Consolidated Aircraft to wire you expressing my opinion on their proposal to locate a plant at FortWorth Texas. We have no objection whatever to such an arrangement if it meets with the approval of the Defense Commission and the War Department. I do not believe that two plants should be located in Dallas but I believe a plant in FortWorth would in no way affect our operations and might in many ways help in that it would tend to create a better arrangement with many of the suppliers of material and equipment and would make it much more worth the while of these vendors to establish service depots and maintain personnel in this district. We are making good progress on the Kansas City plant with the engineer Corps and I will write you more fully about it today. Best wishes for a Happy New Year.
