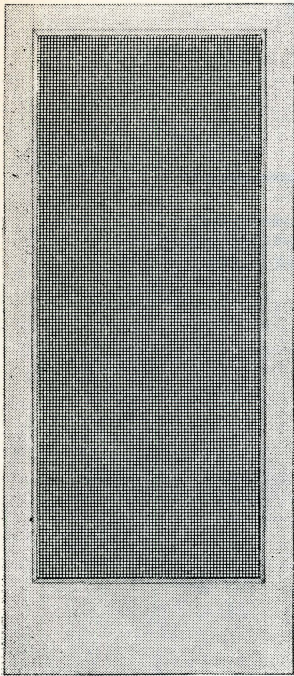
Although, he was not able to be there in person I feel sure that he was with you in spirit, and that he fully approves of the efforts being put forth on this matter.

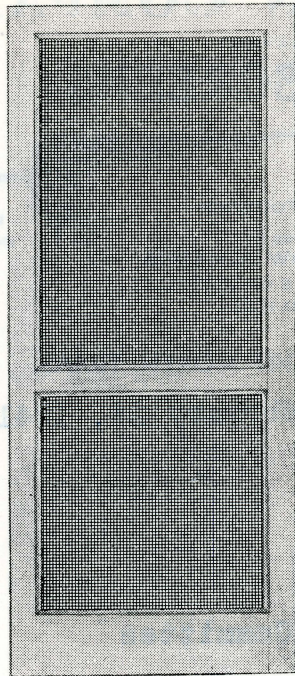

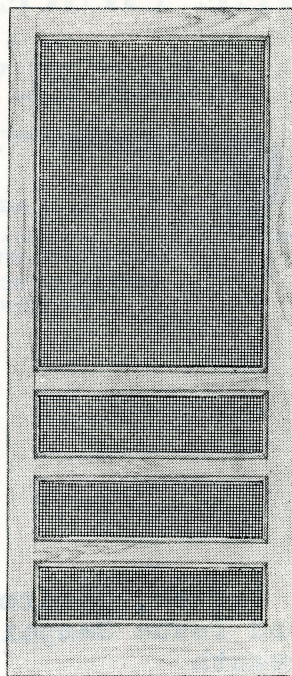

12" Bottom (11 3/4" net)



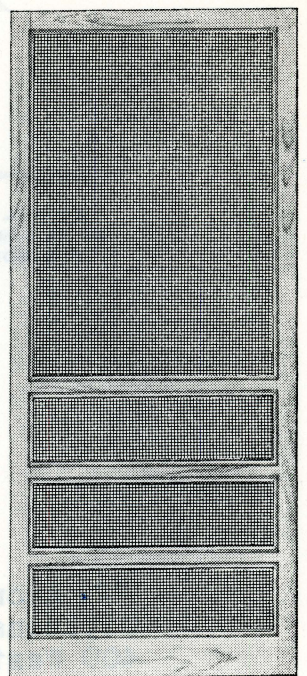
No. 22 CP-28

7 1/4" Bottom Rail



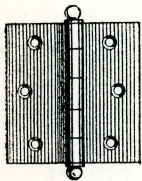

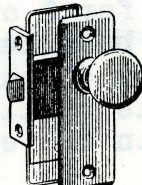
No 500 BUTT HINGE



No 200 BRASS PLATE DOOR PULL



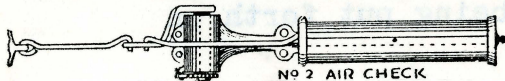

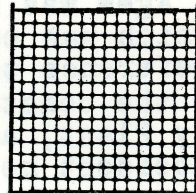

No 4 COIL SPRING

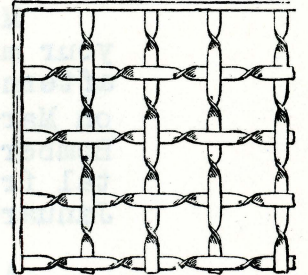

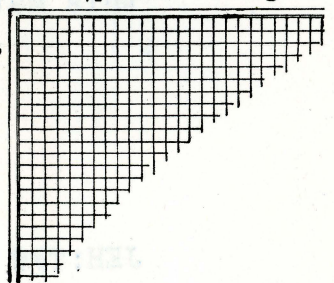

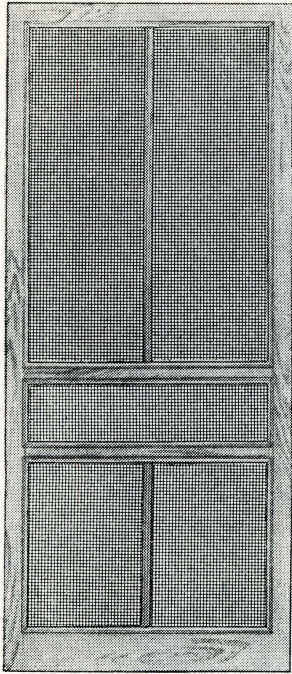


BRASS OR STEEL GUARD RAILS FOR SCREEN DOORS



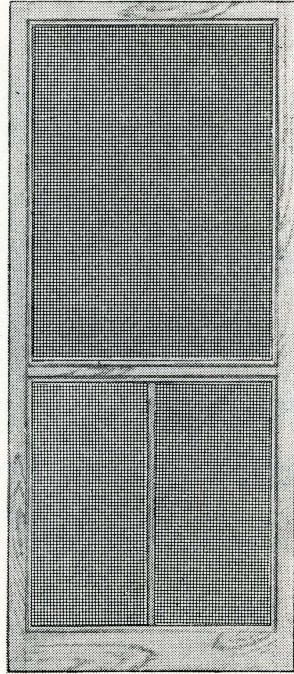

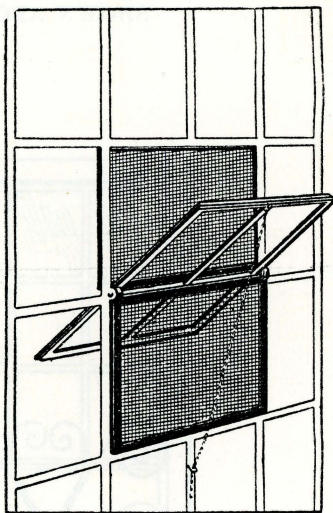


AGEE'S No. 15 Window Screen Hangers

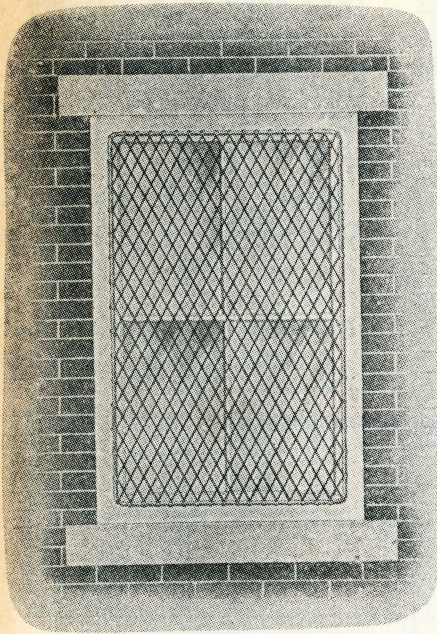

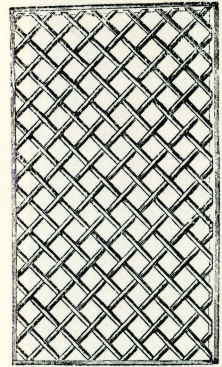

6. They hold screen frames CLOSED even if bottom hooks are unfastened.
7. They require no SCREWS IN CORNER of screen frames which is the life of your screen.
8. Should your screen swell or for any reason need refitting the hangers do not have to be REMOVED.
9. They are put on from the INSIDE of your building and screens on a TWENTY-STORY building may be as easily and RAPIDLY installed as on a one or two-story building.
10. They are CHEAPER than any other hanger when you consider the LITTLE TIME it takes to install them.
11. They are practically INVISIBLE from either outside or inside.

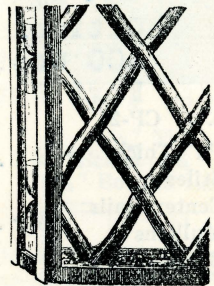


Wire Window Guard in Place Made on Round Iron Frame

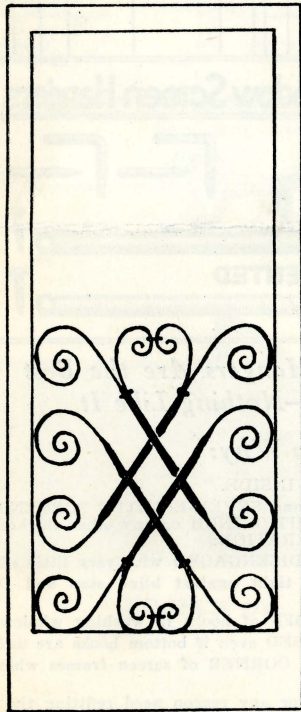

Heavy Wire Window Guard with Channel Iron Frame

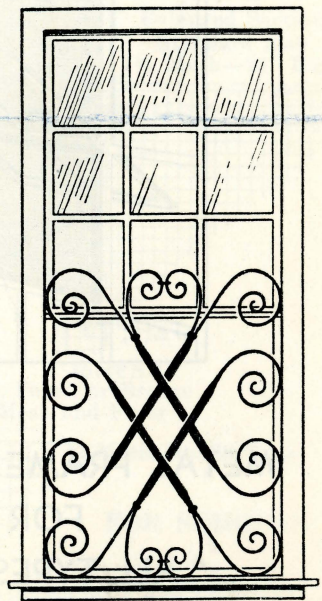


ENLARGED SECTION OF GUARD SHOWN ABOVE
