
Dear Amon:

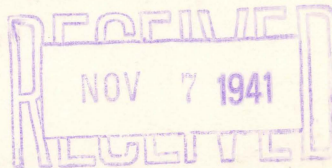
