Dear Amon,



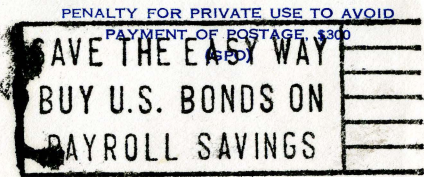
