have broken the world's endurance record - 172

record in an old second hand Ryan Monoplane with
a Wright Whirlwind motor, already used over 50,000
miles, and had practically no assistance nor
special preparation for the flight.

over six-hundred folks present. The front page

the two country boys, who established this record
for Fort Worth.
