In accordance with your request, there are attached copies of correspondence pertaining to our negotiation with the City for more favorable gasolene rates.

You will note at the time Ed Nilson was Director of Aviation for Fort Worth it appeared some equitable arrangement might be worked out but apparently Ed Nilson's recommendation was reversed.

You will note one letter from the City Manager in 1947 advises the City will make no exception to their policy; in view of the fact no reason was given we elected to pursue the subject further.

After again renewing the subject the City Manager stated verbally to Jack Jaynes, Deputy Regional Administrator, and Ed Travis, Chief of Airport Division, that they would work out some satisfactory handling of gasolene if we would go along on the International Airport.

Our relationship with Mr. Jones has been extremely cordial and it is with reluctance I even mention this subject but due to the lapse of time without favorable action by Mr. Jones, we are continuing to pay the high prices and I would like to get the subject settled.

Possibly I am wrong and if so please let the subject drop.
