
Dear Amon:

Bill Curley was very pleased to get it.

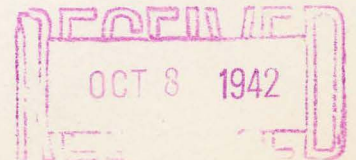
As for tickets for the Army Show, B.C. asked me to tell
