Dear Mr. Hoover:

Please accept my apology for not sooner acknowledging your telegram in early March, advising me to the effect that President Robert L. Johnson, Temple University, would shortly ask me to join the citizens committee on reorganization of the Federal Government. On receipt of the wire from Mr. Johnson, I accepted with the proviso that I could not attend regular meetings; however, that we are tremendously interested in the Hoover reorganization plan, and feel that it should be carried through.

The difficulty, as usual in political matters, is the usual tendency of stating it is okeh for others but not my department, etc. What is good for the goose should be good for the gander, and the recent hearings have thoroughly demonstrated the soundness of your economic program, which we expect to vigorously support.
