

Ike Gets Photo of Birthplace

WASHINGTON, April 29 (INS). President Eisenhower received a color photograph of his birthplace at Denison, Texas, Tuesday and was invited to the dedication of the restored house later this year.

Web Maddox of Fort Worth, president of the Eisenhower Birthplace Foundation, gave the Chief Executive the picture framed in wood taken from the room in which Eisenhower was born Oct. 14, 1890.

Maddox told reporters the President was "much pleased" with the photo and frame as well as an album of pictures showing how the two-story house has been restored and furnished to look just like it did 67 years ago.

The Texan said: "It is perfectly charming, in an old-fashioned sort of way."

Maddox said he also gave the President a picture of his mother and father on their wedding day for display at the restored Eisenhower home.

The restoration, Maddox said, cost less than \$100,000 and the

money was put up by the late Amon Carter, Sid Richardson "and a few other personal friends of the President."

Maddox said that no specific date has yet been planned for the dedication.
