

15-Room Villa Taken as Home By Eisenhowers

PARIS, April 10 (Reuter's).— French sources said Tuesday that General Eisenhower, supreme commander in Europe, and his wife, Mamie, finally have chosen their future home — a 15-room villa at Marnes-la-Coquette, 10 miles west of Paris.

The Eisenhowers, now living in the plush Trianon Palace Hotel at Versailles, probably will move within a month, it was reported.
