Mr. Carter: Milton Amstader and a Mr. Brown² were in today to see you and asked me to pass onto you this information with the hope you'd call General Eaker about it.

Lt. Col. Gordon Graham, commander of base unit, I82AAF, received a message last night signed by General Stratemyer that the district reserve training program for army air corps reserve personnel at Fort Worth Army Air Field would be suspended immediately. The program would be left in effect at Brooks Field, San Antonio; Ellington Field, Houston and Hensely Field, Dallas.

Mr. Brown and Mr. Amstader say there are 1906 reserve air corps officers in the 28 county Fort Worth area; that of these 980 live in Fort Worth and 700 are participating in the program. They maintain that it would be impractic for Hensely field to handle this program because only a small part of that field is available to the Army; the rest is controlled by the Navy.
