I have delayed filing charter amendment papers covering the capital increase from \$250,000 to \$500,000 until the canvas of all stockholders was complete.

We can not use the paid-in subscription which I have deposited in the "Capital Special Account" at Fort Worth National until the papers are filed and approved in Austin.

The banks are anxious for payment of the interest on the \$750,000 loan to satisfy examiners.


I have collected all subscriptions referred to me, completed legal and administrative details, and submit herewith the documents for your approval and signature. When you have approved and signed, I will immediately go to Austin and personally walk the papers through there.

Subscriptions including yours and Sid's in the amount of \$25,000 each, total \$225,200 of which \$191,450 is paid in including the \$7,500.00 from Tom Byrne and \$2,500.00 from Joe Pelich. This leaves an additional \$12,400 each for you and Sid to subscribe according to the plan we discussed.

This additional subscription of yours and Sid's need not be paid for two years in whole or in part, and/or with the consent of other stockholders which surely would be given, it can be nullified by a capital reduction. If all this is agreeable, please sign on the top line above the other signatures.

It has been a pleasure to render these services and I will make the funds available for corporate uses upon return of the papers.
