Dear Frank:

Consolidated Vultee subscribed for 150 shares of the original \$100 par Common stock of Fort Worth Air Terminal, Inc., and prior to September 2, 1949, paid for one half of same, receiving Certificate No. 4 for 75 shares on that date. Original capital was \$250,000.

The remaining 75 shares were paid for prior to August, 1951. Certificate No. 4 was cancelled and Certificate No. 40 was issued on November 8, 1950, to Consolidated Vultee for 150 shares.

General Dynamics subscribed to 150 shares of the \$250,000 capital increase and paid for same by check on June 25, 1954. Certificate No. 60 was issued on August 9, 1954, to cover. On October 22, 1954, Certificate No. 60, together with Certificate No. 55 issued to General Dynamics in replacement of Certificate No. 40 (issued to Consolidated Vultee), was sent to General Dynamics, 445 Park Avenue, New York 22, and receipt was acknowledged by Lambert J. Gross, Vice President, on November 12, 1954.

The 100% capital increase in 1954 was issued in Class "A" Redeemable Common Capital Stock. General Dynamics is on this date the the record owner of 150 shares Common stock and 150 shares Class "A" Redeemable Common Capital stock for which there was paid into the Fort Worth Air Terminal, Inc., treasury the sum of \$30,000.

A Voting Trust Depository was set up and the original issue of 2500 shares of common stock was deposited therein in exchange for Trust Certificates. Therefore, your New York office probably has a Trust Certificate for that stock. The Stock Certificate is probably in that Depository

which would be in Mr. Carter's office. Mr. Amon G. Carter, Sr., Sid W. Richardson and Marvin Leonard were the Trustees. Only Mr. Leonard survives.
