Star-Telegram Backs Eisenhower

FORT WORTH—(P)—The Fort Worth Star-Telegram said editorilly Saturday night the man best suited for the presidency is Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower.*

Noting that the general hasn't expressed himself on many public issues, the editorial says "people have come to place no great confidence in political statements and campaign pronouncements . . . in the last analysis a candidate must be accepted on faith."
