Backs Eisenhower

FORT WORTH —(AP)—The Fort Worth Star-Telegram said editorially Saturday night the man best suited for the presidency is Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower.

Noting that the general hasn't expressed himself on many public issues, the editorial says "people have come to place no great confidence in political statements and campaign pronouncements . . . in the last analysis a candidate must be accepted on faith."

The newspaper, which is Independent-Democratic, quotes Eisenhower as saying: "I have no end to serve but the good of the United States." It asks: "What better platform could any presidential candidate have?"
