and Philadelphia with Davey O'Brien and Dutch Meyer.

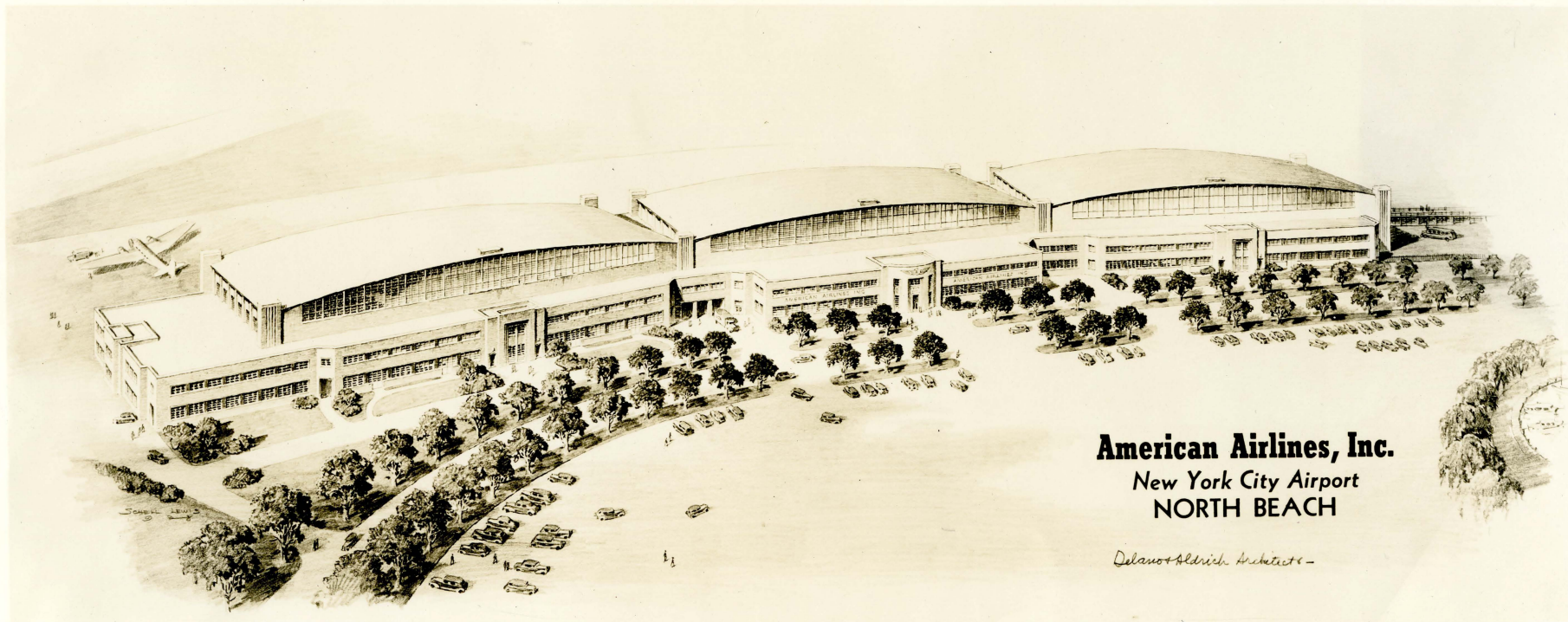
Under the circumstances, Mr. Carter
