We represent Mr. William Randolph Hearst and other defendants in the suit by stockholders of Hearst Consolidated Publications, Inc., entitled Mann v. Hearst, et al., now pending in the Superior Court of Los Angeles County. This is the suit which Mr. Alofsin of King Features Syndicate has discussed with you previously.

We are advised by Mr. Alofsin that you have very graciously consented to aid us with your testimony by deposition upon one of the issues, viz., that the salary paid Mr. Hearst by Consolidated over a seven year period was excessive.
