*All Newark figures with the exception of Eastern Air Lines, which is not operating into New York, are distorted because on all trips from New York to other points passing through Newark a round trip is counted as two arrivals (one in each direction) and two departures (one in each direction) making a total count of 4. Actually the Newark movements would be better understood by describing on a basis whereby round trips are given the same count as trips terminating and originating at Newark on which basis the following count for all air lines would apply:
