

# B-36 Probers Delay Flight

WASHINGTON, Aug. 15. — Because of a speaking engagement in St. Louis, Subcommittee Chairman Melvin Price, Illinois, of the House armed services committee has postponed start of his group's flight to California to take testimony from Gen. H. H. Arnold in the B-36 investigation.

The subcommittee will leave Washington in an Air Force plane for the West Coast at 11 a. m. Tuesday, his office reported Monday. The plane will pick him up at St. Louis and fly directly to Los Angeles.

Price left for St. Louis Saturday morning.

It was speculated here that the subcommittee would visit Fort Worth, where the B-36s are made by Consolidated Vultee Aircraft Company, either going or coming from California, but Price declined to confirm that a Fort Worth stop would be made. It had been originally planned to start the California trip Sunday night or Monday morning.
