My interest in the Osteopathic Profession and sincere belief that this profession by virtue of their educational background and training should enjoy equal privileges and rights on a par with the medical profession and, after reviewing the testimony and suggestions of the American Osteopathic Association before the preparedness Subcommittee, of which you are Chairman, in Reference to S. 1, I hope you will insert the Amendments as suggested by the American Osteopathic Association, of which you have a copy PARAGRAPH

Congress on numerous occasions in its Legislation has indicated its acceptance of Osteopathy on an equal basis with medicine. They are included in the Doctor's Draft Law. It is certainly not the intent of Congress to cripple their schools or to deny them the right to serve as medical officers in the armed services when military and civilian authorities are all pleading for more physicians to serve the country. PARAGRAPH

It is high time the Administrative Authorities follow the dictates of Congress in matters pertaining to this profession instead of deviating to suit their own choice in the matter. I am 100% for Osteopathy and credit it with helping me to keep on my feet now.
