My dear Mr. Carter:

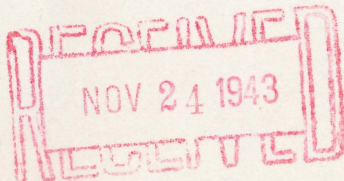
Thank you for your letter of November 11 and for giving me a chance to read a copy of your telegram to Justice Byrnes. I have read this with interest.
