

# Dallas Orders Port Surveys

DALLAS, Sept. 2 (AP).—Surveys to determine prospective locations for one to three master airports that can be developed with runways 15,000 feet long and vast hangar and freight terminal facilities were ordered by city councilmen Thursday almost coincident with land purchases made to expand Love Field.

City Manager V. R. Smitham also was asked to have studies made immediately on improving trafficways between Love Field and the downtown district, including improvements on Lemmon Avenue, better connections with Hines Boulevard and other routes designed to make the airport more useful in the future aviation picture.

A formal decision on the stand to be taken on the Midway Airport proposal made by Secretary of Commerce Jones will not be made until after next Tuesday, Mayor Woodall Rodgers said.
