Dallas, Fort Worth  
In Row Over Airport

WASHINGTON, March 22.—Civil Aeronautics Administrator Charles I. Stanton heard testimony today in a controversy between Dallas and Fort Worth over the location of the administration building at the airport being constructed midway between the two cities.

Dallas concluded its testimony at a morning session, and Fort Worth was expected to complete its case at the afternoon meeting. Representatives of Dallas will be given an opportunity for rebuttal of the Fort Worth case.

The controversy is over whether the building is located on the west side of the field facing Fort Worth, or on the north side, as Dallas desires, according to Mayor Woodall Rogers of Dallas. The CAA has recommended the west side location and construction so far has proceeded on this basis.

Secretary of Commerce Jesse Jones presided at the hearing. Nathan Adams, chairman of the Dallas city midway airport committee, was in charge of the Dallas group's testimony, and Amon Carter, publisher, led the Fort Worth delegation.
