Dear Mr. Secretary:

Replying to your letter of November 1st, 1943 with reference to the re-location of the administration building and passenger station on the North East corner of the present airport along Highway 183.

We wish to state that we have already notified you that for the sake of compromise and to help the Administrator that the Northwest location was agreeable to the City of Arlington, only to compromise the difference between Ft. Worth and Dallas, which seemed to us was a fair compromise for all interested parties.

However at this time, we feel that we are justified in entering a protest against the recent proposal to establish same on the North East corner.

We have been and are still sincere in our efforts to compromise the difference yet we do not feel that we should sacrifice the maximum usefulness of our airport.
