airplanes be scrapped, that the size of the fleet be reduced.

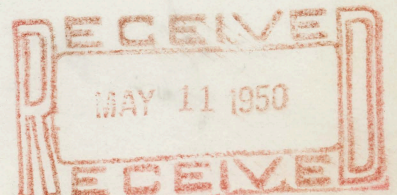
He is not a stockholder of record.
