The Hamburg Sport Verein soccer team, first Germany soccer team ever to compete in the United States, will fly to New York by American Overseas Airlines on or about May 4. The team will play its first match on May 7 at Triboro Stadium, which will be followed by a series of games with leading U.S. soccer teams in Rochester, Chicago, Newark, Philadelphia and Brooklyn.

Fifteen members of the Hamburg team, their coach and a trainer, accompanied by a member of the Hamburg Senate, the honorary president of the Hamburg Sport Verein, and two newspapermen - 21 altogether - will make the trip.

The American debut of the Hamburg Club will be against a team composed of top soccer players selected from 28 clubs comprising the German-American Soccer League at Triboro Stadium, Randall's Island on Sunday, May 7.

The trip and matches are sanctioned by the New York State Soccer Association, The United States Soccer Association, and the F.I.F.A. (International Soccer Football Association).

The Hamburg group has twice captured the championship of the British Zone of Occupation since the end of the war, and upon its return to Germany will compete for the German Soccer Championship.
