American Overseas Airlines will airlift the entire group of German exhibitors, totalling 160, to the first United States International Trade Fair in Chicago during August. The flights will originate at Frankfurt.

The exhibitors, representing 250 German firms, will occupy 16,000 square feet of space. They will be the second largest group at the fair, with France leading. The exhibitors describe participation in the fair as one of Western Germany's biggest efforts to increase export trade since the ERP went into effect.

AOA was selected by the German fair committee for the second time, having already carried a similar group to last year's German Industry Fair in New York. This year's fair, in which 39 countries will participate, will be held in Chicago from Aug. 7 until Aug. 20.
