American Overseas Airlines inaugurated a new air service between Hamburg and Berlin, Germany, last Friday (June 23), vice-president and general manager Harold R. Harris announced. The new flights augment AOA's present 11 weekly round-trips between New York, Frankfurt and Berlin and two weekly trips between New York and Hamburg.

The new flights for passengers, mail and cargo will operate every Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday on a frequency of one round-trip a day. The flights leave Berlin at 8:30 a.m., arriving at Hamburg at 9:45 a.m., and leave Hamburg at 10:30 a.m., arriving at Tempelhof at 11:45 a.m.

The one way fare is \$17 or 70 Deutsche marks. Round-trip fare is \$30 or 126 Deutsche marks. Air cargo rates are 12¢ or 49 pfennigs per pound. A 25% reduction is granted for shipments exceeding 100 pounds.

The 166-mile air route between Germany's capital and its principal seaport lies over the Russian zone of occupation and the British zone, in which Hamburg lies.

The flights will be in 64-passenger DC-4 Flagships.
