Dear Mr. Carter:


Upon Mr. Grant's return from New York this week, I have taken up with him your request of September 15th that we send you a check each week upon completion of the week's performance instead of waiting to make the payment in accordance with the contract -- upon completion of the second period of eight weeks.

Accordingly, I am enclosing check for \$9,375 covering the three-weeks period of September 12th to October 2nd, inclusive, and no doubt we can arrange to send checks weekly thereafter.
