

We had a good meeting in Fort Worth and I was able to cover many activities in a short period of time. I am certainly impressed with the Greater Fort Worth International Airport.

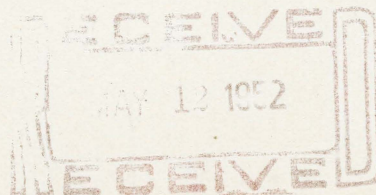
