Publisher to Make Pacific Ocean Flight

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 23. (UP) —Amon Carter, Fort Worth, Texas, publisher and long-time friend of the late Will Rogers, will be one of seven passengers on the Pan-American airways clipper ship when it inaugurates transpacific passenger service Oct. 21, it was revealed today.

Carter, through Will Rogers, made his reservation for the flight three years ago when Rogers gave the airways company a check for the crossing for Carter and himself, officials said.

The other six passengers will be selected according to the date their reservations were received. One of those who will not make the flight was said to be a Hollywood actress, who, when she was told that she was No. 319 on a list of 100 persons, offered to charter the entire plane for the trip. Her offer was rejected, as were those who wanted to go as mail at \$1.50 an ounce, or livestock at \$4.13 a pound.
