**CARTER ACCEPTS
CHINA AIR RIDE**

Fort Worth, Tex., Sept. 24.—(UP) Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth publisher, today telegraphed his acceptance of an invitation to be one of seven passengers when air passenger service is inaugurated between the United States and China next month.

Carter was invited by Juan Trigg, president of Pan-American Airlines, whose "clipper" flying boats will operate over the San Francisco to Shanghai route.

Trigg invited Carter and Will Rogers, cowboy-humorist, to make the flight three years ago, long before Rogers died in an Alaskan air crash, Carter said. The publisher and Rogers were close friends.
