**PILOT OF CHINA
CLIPPER IS KIN
OF LOCAL LADY**

One of the pilots of the trans-Pacific China Clipper plane of the Pan American Airways is Mr. Harold Jarold. That statement in itself might not mean much to residents of Center, but it took on a lot of interest when it was learned today that he is the husband of the granddaughter of a local lady, Mrs. Hamp Bell.

The China Clipper has made other trips across the Pacific but not on a regular schedule and carrying passengers until this week. Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, arrived in Los Angeles yesterday to become one of the first seven passengers to fly with the clipper. Carter went because of a request made by the late Will Rogers, who when the trans-Pacific line was proposed, left them a blank check with the request: "See that I get the first ticket, and put Amon Carter down too, because he wouldn't miss a chance like that."

On the initial passenger-carrying trip Mr. Jarold will be one of the pilots.
