

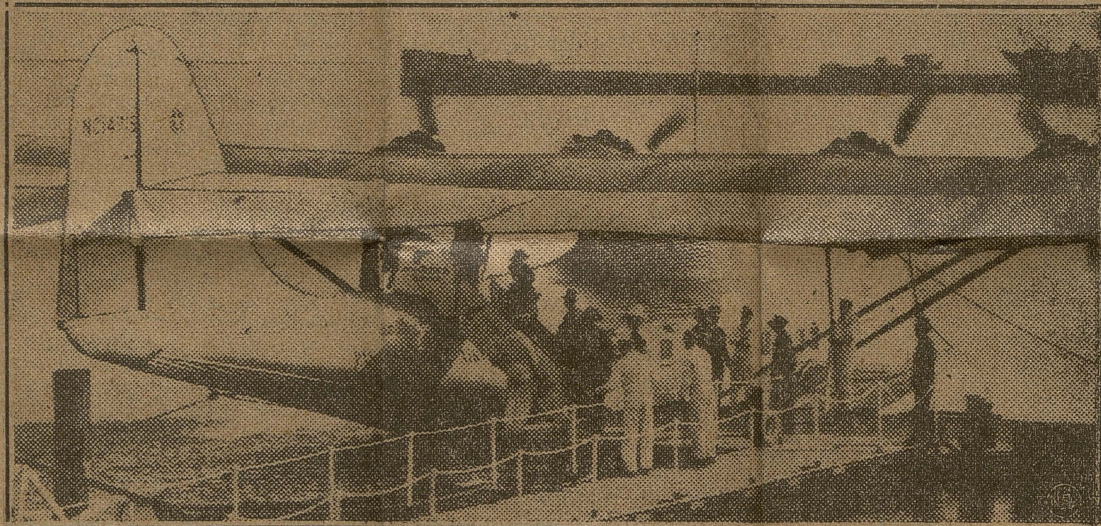
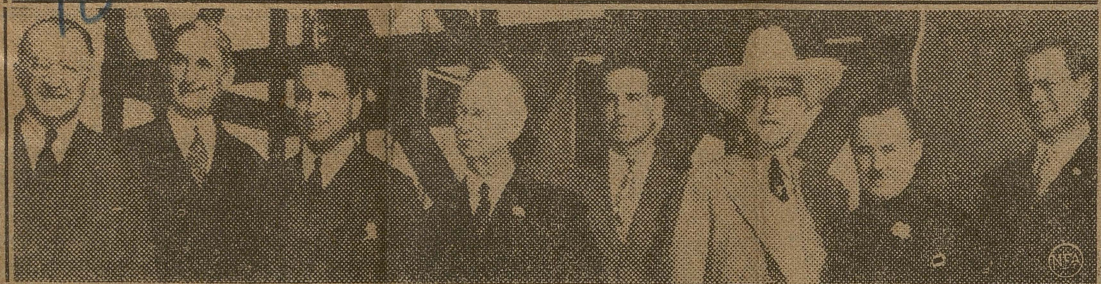

90 **Off to Manila on Last Clipper 'Preview' Hop**



Leaders in business, finance and politics were passengers on the second and last "preview" flight across the Pacific of the Pan-American Airways' Clipper ships.
