Three years ago, Mr. Carter and Will Rogers each paid \$1,000 for round trip tickets over the proposed passenger plane route from Alameda, California to Manila, P. I. They wanted to make sure of being among the first to make the first round trip.

Amon G. Carter was one of eight men to make the trip the past week on the Phillippine Clipper. "If anything should happen to either of us," Will Rogers said, "the other will go right on and make the trip."

"It might have been a premonition," Mr. Carter said in discussing the matter with the Leader editor in August. Anyway, Mr. Carter is the only Texas man aboard, and he's thinking of Will a whole lot of the time as they fly over great wastes of water, wishing that Will Rogers was along.
