# Clipper Ends First Pay Trip

## Flying Boat Wings From Hawaii in 20 Hours

The Philippine Clipper returned to the Alameda Airport at 10:55 o'clock yesterday morning from Honolulu, carrying passengers and completing the "preliminary tour" of the air route.

Regular paid passenger service opened with its westward flight on October 21.

Passengers aboard the clipper, commanded by Captain J. H. Tilton, included Sentor and Mrs. McAdoo, Amon Carter, Fort Worth, Tex., publisher; Thomas H. Beck, president of the Crowell Publishing Company, New York, and James G. Sahlman, Eastern newspaper publisher.

They were guests of President Juan T. Trippe of the Pan-American Line.

Flight time was reported as 20 hours and 6 minutes.
