## *Agreement For Refund*

1. CLAIMANT - Sign the Agreement for Refund, when you receive the voucher check.
2. AGREEMENT - See instructions at bottom of form.
3. PLEASE - Check the numbers on the agreement and voucher check. They should agree.
4. BE SURE - The dollar amount on the voucher check and agreement are the same.
5. SURETY - Not required, unless specifically requested by the one who surrenders the voucher check or definite reference is contained in the letter attached to the agreement.
6. IMPORTANT - IF THE TRAVELERS CHEQUES ARE RECOVERED, PLEASE TAKE THEM OUT OF CIRCULATION. CANCEL THE FACSIMILE SIGNATURE HOWARD A. SMITH - MAIL THEM TO -
