

Excerpt of Letter to Lieut.Col.Wm.Kimball,USAAF
From Lieut.Col.A.P.Clark Jr. USAAF, #594 Stalag Luft 3, Germany

Dear Bill.

February 20, 1943

May God bless you for your letter and the food parcel. I just received your Xmas card, note and the parcel packed September 28th. Space does not permit names of other U.S.prisoners of war. Would suggest you contact Red Cross Headquarters and obtain same. Recommend Miss Jackson(Parcels for Prisoners of War) be advised that British Prisoners of War benefit regularly from her fine work. It would be nice if she could do as well for U.S. prisoners of war ! Maj. Houston is my Adj. We have a fine group here are are getting along O.K.----- Col. C.G.Goodrich, Lt.Col.Sam Agee are in Germany and will soon be here. Maj. D.M.Jones, 866 and Capt.J.M. Bennett, 786, are here. Al. Rutherford was killed in France. Say hello to anyone interested and don't worry about us. Cheerio.
