Stalag Luft 3, Germany

"I was quite surprised but very happy to receive your Xmas card. Many thanks for your efforts. Col. Clark, with whom I room, spoke very highly of you when I showed him your card. Yesterday he received his first food parcel. You had sent it. Believe me it was quite an event. He is the first U.S.A.A.F. P.O.W. (U.S. Army Air Force prisoner of war) to receive a food parcel. He shared it with all of us Americans, but when a parcel is divided into hundreds of parts, it doesn't last very long. Again many thanks,
