

Dear Mr. Amon,

Our Government advises us to continue to send Next of Kin food parcels to the old addresses of the Prisoners of War whose camps have been moved and that the parcels will be forwarded to the new location.

However, we have had word from our Canadian dealers that they can not accept orders for tobacco to be sent to the Prison Camps that have been moved, because of present Canadian Government regulation. We are, therefore, holding your order and money until we hear again from the Canadian concern. We hope, as they relocate the Camps, that the new addresses will come through and we can send the cigarettes as ordered.
