**FOR THE BUSINESSMAN:** Furthermore useful information will be found regarding numerals and commercial terms, loans, equivalents of weights and measures, form letters for business, banking, requesting club membership, gas and electricity service, and how to make out cheques. There is also a glossary of packing-house and wool-buying terms.

**FOR THE HOUSEWIFE:** Housewives will find useful sentences for shopping, giving instructions to the beauty-parlour attendant, dressmaker, maid, cook, laundress or gar-

dener. Also the equivalents of dress sizes and shoe numbers as well as the names of all items of furniture, linen, household utensils, electrical appliances and supplies, colours, meat cuts, fish, vegetables, fruits, groceries, etc., are included.

**FOR ALL THREE:** The last section of the book is devoted to those verbs that are in daily use, their conjugations, rules, peculiarities, etc.
