Dear Mrs. Deakins,

I promised to let you know when the certificates Mr. Carter sent in were transferred to his son and daughter so that you could use this date on the Securities and Exchange Form 4 which we sent you.

Enclosed is copy of a letter received from our Transfer Agent in Chicago which would indicate that the transaction was completed on October 24th.

You will also note that the Federal Transfer Tax was \$8.40 instead of \$4.80 as we had been informed by a New York bank. If Mr. Carter has not yet sent a check covering this would you kindly explain that the tax was incorrectly figured and that it was \$8.40 instead of \$4.80. We have paid the tax and the transaction is completely closed.
